With unemployment rates at their highest in decades and the increase of uninsured individuals, our mission and our efforts have never been more critical.

TEAM CAPTAIN CHECKLIST

	Set a recruitment goal. We recommend having at least 10 members to a team, or if you're a corporate team, 20% of your workforce.	
	Host a team kickoff meeting. Ask us about 300 Dallas' Team Rally Package to help energize your team's fundraising efforts!	
	Personalize your Participant Center. Don't believe it makes a difference? Think again! Last year, our fundraisers who updated their personal page raised on average \$343 more than those who didn't.	
	Send E-Mails from your Participant Center. Log in to recruit and manage team members, request donations and download fundraising resources. Use our prepared e-mail templates or create your own!	
	Set a team fundraising goal. Aim high and have each team member commit to fundraising! Last year the average fundraising participant raised \$278. Are you up for that challenge? We know you can do it!	
	Fundraise from your Facebook page. Download the Boundless Fundraising application for Facebook to get your friends and fans in on the action! Social media is a great tool in recruiting team members, donors and sharing your successes for Race.	
	Display event materials. Raise awareness in your office, neighborhood, campus and other high traffic areas to generate new team members or donations! Download printable team posters from our team page by visiting komen-dallas.org.	
	Attend the Team Captain Kickoff. Mark your calendars for August 8th and join us at the Sheraton Galleria for a fun and helpful event that will surely get you motivated to lead your team to success!	
	Ask your human resources department about your company's Matching Gift Program. Be sure and have each of your team members do the same. This is an easy way to double your donations at no out cost to you or your donor.	
	Share communications from our Affiliate. As a team captain we rely on you to share all communications you receive from us with your team.	
	Invite Komen Dallas County to do a lunch and learn at your place of work. Use this opportunity to educate your co-workers about the impact your team is making by fundraising to support breast health in Dallas County.	

WHERE DO I START

Fundraising Tips

Fundraising should be fun not feared! Share these tips with your team to empower them to achieve their individual goals:

- Everyone is a potential donor
- Ask people that you have daily contact with or who you have an established relationship with. Start with the person whom you think will give you the largest donation to establish a high baseline of giving
- Ask at least 1 person per day to make a donation
- Aim high ask for \$50 and settle for \$25, instead of asking for \$25 and settling for \$10

Team Fundraisers

Putting together team fundraisers is a great way to engage all team members to raise funds and have fun doing it! Increase your impact by keeping costs low. As you read through these ideas and create your own, think of possible items that can be donated or local businesses that could sponsor your team or event.

- Percent of Sales. Ask local merchants if they will donate a percentage of their sales on a specific day to your Race team.
- Yard Sale. Get your friends and contacts to donate their goods to your yard sale with all proceeds going to your Race team to support Komen Dallas County. Ask people who have just held yard sales to donate what didn't sell to your sale.
- Cover Charge at Local Venue. See if a local venue would be willing to have the cover charge for a particular night benefit your Race team.
- **Sports Event/Tournament.** Mini-golf, tennis, bowl-a-thon, dance-a-thon, aerobics and other sports can all be set up as events or tournaments with all proceeds going to your Race team. Keep the cost low by utilizing a gaming system like Wii, PS3 or XBOX.
- Bake Sale. Ask your friends, family and co-workers to show off their cooking talents and donate treats for a bake sale! Host the event at work, in your neighborhood, your local market or church!
- Car Wash. Consider selling presale tickets for your car wash that way you can have an idea of how many people will come to your car wash and if they never show up at least you still have the donation!

Additional Tips

Brainstorm with your team. Be creative and think of things that can involve the entire group. Advertise your participation as much as possible and just ask people! Too often people just don't know how to get involved.

The more excitement you create, the more people will want to be a part of it! If you are having fun, your team will too!

Each year Komen Dallas County receives grant requests for local organizations that provide breast health resources for uninsured and underinsured Dallas County residents. With dailv visits to the gym and her recommended annual mammograms, was Jan proactive. and healthy.

When she found out she had breast cancer in Oct. 2008, she was in total shock.

Having just started teaching at a new school with much success. Jan decided to reschedule her yearly mammogram one month sooner to coincide with Breast Cancer Awareness month. When she received the call from her nurse the following morning to come in for another mammogram and ultrasound,

Jan assumed it was another false alarm. "As they were doing the follow up ultrasound," she said. "the doctor indicated that I needed to return for a biopsy. I assumed that they meant sometime in the following fit week. He said, 'No, not next Go tell your husband, week. eat something, and come back after lunch."

> Jan's final diagnosis was stage 3. HER2+ breast cancer with node involvement. lvmph The cancer was invasive and aggressive.

> After a mastectomy, 18 rounds of chemotherapy, 33 treatments of radiation, and an intricate DIEP flap reconstruction, Jan is happy to call herself a survivor.

Having been an avid supporter for Komen Dallas County for more than five years we were honored to award her as our Champion Survivor at the 2013 Impact Awards Luncheon.

Jan's message to women? "Have a mammogram. I had mammograms for 12 years. I went early and was already at Stage III." She also encourages everyone to not fear fundraising. "I've done all the fundraising by myself (donations from friends, family, and co-workers), no fundraising aiaantic small donations from friends and family allow them to feel like they are helping find a cure. And every contribution matters!"
